

# The 2019 Murrays Bay ICEBREAKER

**Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2019**

**Murrays Bay, North Shore, Auckland.**

The Organising Authority is the Murrays Bay Sailing Club.

## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. For other than the Optimist Green Fleet the regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. For the Optimist Green Fleet the regatta will be governed by the “New Zealand International Optimist Dinghy Association Green Fleet Rules for Racing version 2010-01 – May 2010” available from <https://sites.google.com/site/nzcentreboardstandardsis/>.
- 1.3. The YNZ Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply. Notwithstanding the dispensation granted by Yachting New Zealand, sailboard competitors shall comply with clause 1.
- 1.4. RRS Appendix P, *Special Procedures for Rule 42*, will apply as amended by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.5. For protests where only a rule of Part 2, *When Boats Meet*, or rule 31, *Touching a Mark*, is alleged to have been broken, an arbitration hearing may be offered prior to any formal protest hearing.

### 2. FORMAT

- 2.1. This championship is a one day regatta for junior, youth and senior classes including Optimist Green, Optimist Open, Open Skiff (Bic), P Class, Starling Green, Starling, Laser 4.7, Laser Radial, Laser, RS Feva, 420, 29er, 470, Nacra, Zephyr & Waszp.
- 2.2. A minimum of 4 boats per class is required for a separate fleet to be sailed.

### **3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

3.1. The regatta is open to all Optimist Green, Optimist Open, Open Skiff (Bic), P Class, Starling Green, Starling, Laser 4.7, Laser Radial, Laser, RS Feva, 420, 29er, 470, Nacra, Zephyr & Waszp complying with their class rules provided 4 or more of any class enters by the closing time of 1100hrs Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2019.

3.2. Entry Fees are:

Single Handed Classes \$30.00

Double Handed Classes \$40.00

3.3. To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a member of a club or other organisation affiliated to the National Authority.

3.4. Entries will not be accepted from, or may be cancelled for, any boat not displaying its correct sail number or displaying the same sail number as any other boat in the same race.

3.5. Participating sailors / crews must complete an entry form and pay at registration from 0900hrs Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2019.

### **4. ENTRY CLOSING DATE**

4.1. Entries will be accepted up to 1100 on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2019.

### **5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

5.1. The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at MBSC.

5.2. The Regatta Specific Schedule will be available at MBSC on race day.

### **6. VENUE**

6.1. The regatta will be based at Murrays Bay Sailing Club.

6.2. Racing will take place on the waters off Murrays Bay Beach.

### **7. PROGRAMME**

7.1. Registration will be from 0900Hrs on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2019

7.2. Racing Schedule:

Briefing 1100hrs

Race 1 1200hrs (Time of first warning signal)

Race 2 Back to Back

Race 3 Back to Back

Race 4 Back to back

Prize giving As soon as possible after Race 4.

### **8. ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES**

8.1. For the 29er classes rule 44.1, *Taking a Penalty*, is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

## **9. SCORING**

9.1. One race is required to be completed to constitute a championship.

## **10. LAUNCHING RESTRICTIONS**

10.1. All boats, excluding Senior classes, will be required to launch and retrieve from Murrays Bay beach except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.
