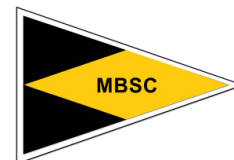

SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSI)

This sheet and Attachment A, are supplements to Appendix S of the Racing Rules of Sailing (*page 136 RRS 2017-2020*).

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS (SI 2)

SSI 1 The race office is located in the MBSC Clubhouse. Notices to competitors will be placed on the official notice board in the sailors room on level 2 of the MBSC clubhouse.

SIGNALS MADE ASHORE (SI 4)

SSI 2 Signals ashore will be displayed on the MBSC flagstaff.

SSI 3 A boat shall not leave the shore until code flag D is displayed.

SSI 4 The warning signal shall be made not less than 30 minutes after flag D is displayed or not before the scheduled time, whichever is the later.

SSI 5 SCHEDULE OF COURSES AND START TIMES (SI 5 & 6)

Day/Date	Course	Time of first warning signal
Sat 19 th May	A	10:25
Sun 20 th May	A	10:25

SSI 6 On Sunday 20th May, no warning signal will be made after 1530 hours.

SCHEDULE OF RACES AND CLASS FLAGS (SI 5 & 6)

SSI 8 If more than three (3) races have been sailed, then the last race of the series will be a MEDAL RACE. This will be signalled by the Race Committee vessel by flying a white flag with the letter M. This will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.

COURSES (SI 7)

SSI 9 The courses to be sailed, the order in which the marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left are shown in Attachment A

MARKS (SI 8)

SSI 10 The description of the marks is below each course diagram.

THE START (SI 9)

SSI 11 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee vessel, and the course side of the starting mark, or if the port end starting mark is a vessel, the staff on it displaying an orange flag. This changes SI 9.2.

SSI 12 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.

SSI 13 A boat starting later than four minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A4.1 and RRS A5.

THE FINISH (SI 11)

SSI 14 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the race committee vessel and the course side of the finishing mark.

SSI 15 TIME LIMITS (SI 12)

Fleet/Class	Target time for first finisher	Finish Window	Time Limit for first finisher
Course A Scheduled races 1 - 9	30 minutes	15 minutes	45 minutes
Course A - Medal Race	20 minutes	10 minutes	35 minutes

There is no prescribed time limit for the first boat to pass mark 1.

PENALTY SYSTEM

SSI 15 For the 29er, rule 44.1, Taking a Penalty, is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

SSI 16 Appendix P is changed by SSI 15 and SSI 17

SSI 17 RRS P2.2 and P2.3 are deleted and RRS P2.1 is amended to "When a boat is penalised under RRS P2.1 her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty under RRS 44.2. If she fails to take it she shall be disqualified without a hearing."

SSI 18 Breaches of Class Rules and Safety Regulations may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

CHECK OUT AND CHECK IN

SSI 19 Boats shall comply with the following check out and check in procedure: Sign on and off sheets are to be signed by all sailors each day, prior to leaving the beach, and immediately after returning to the beach at the end of racing.

SUPPORT VESSELS

SSI 20 Except when participating in rescue operations, coaches, parents and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first fleet to start until all boats have finished or retired or the Race Committee signals a postponement or an abandonment (but not a general recall) of all fleets.

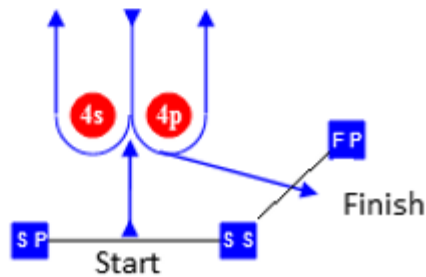
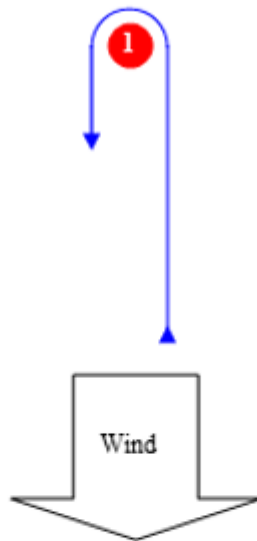
SSI 21 When a Race Committee or Protest Committee member indicates a support vessel to move further from the course area, the mentioned vessel shall do so immediately.
