SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSI)

This sheet and Attachment A are supplements to Appendix S of the Racing Rules of Sailing.

RULES

SSI 1 The Yachting New Zealand Prescriptions 2017-2020 and The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.

Appendix T will apply

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS (SI 2)

SSI 2 The race office is located at on the middle floor of the Murrays Bay Sailing Club. Notices to competitors will be placed on the official notice board at the back wall of the middle floor of the Murrays Bay Sailing Club.

SIGNALS MADE ASHORE (SI 4)

SSI 3 Signals ashore will be displayed on the flagstaff located at The Murrays Bay Sailing Club.

SSI 4 A boat shall not leave the shore until flag D is displayed. The warning signal will be made not less than 60 minutes after flag D is displayed or not before the scheduled time, whichever is the later.

SSI 5 When a visual signal is displayed over a fleet or course flag, the signal applies only to that fleet or course. This changes Race Signals preamble.

SSI 7 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1700hrs.

COURSES (SI 7)

SSI 8 The courses to be sailed, the order in which the marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left are shown in Attachment A.

MARKS (SI 8)

SSI 9 The description of the marks are:

Mark 1	Orange Cylinder
Mark 1a	Black Cylinder
Marks 4p/4s	Orange Cylinder
Starting Mark Starboard End	Committee Boat "Island Style"
Starting Mark Port End	Red Cylinder
Finish Mark Starboard End	Red Cylinder
Finish Mark Port End	Committee Boat "Island Style"
Change of Course Mark	Blue Cylinder

THE START (SI 9)

SSI 10 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.

SSI 11 When a starting sequence is in progress, boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area. The starting area is defined as the area 50 metres from the starting line and all marks in all directions.

SSI 12 A boat starting later than four minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A4.1

There is no prescribed time limit for the first boat to pass mark 1.

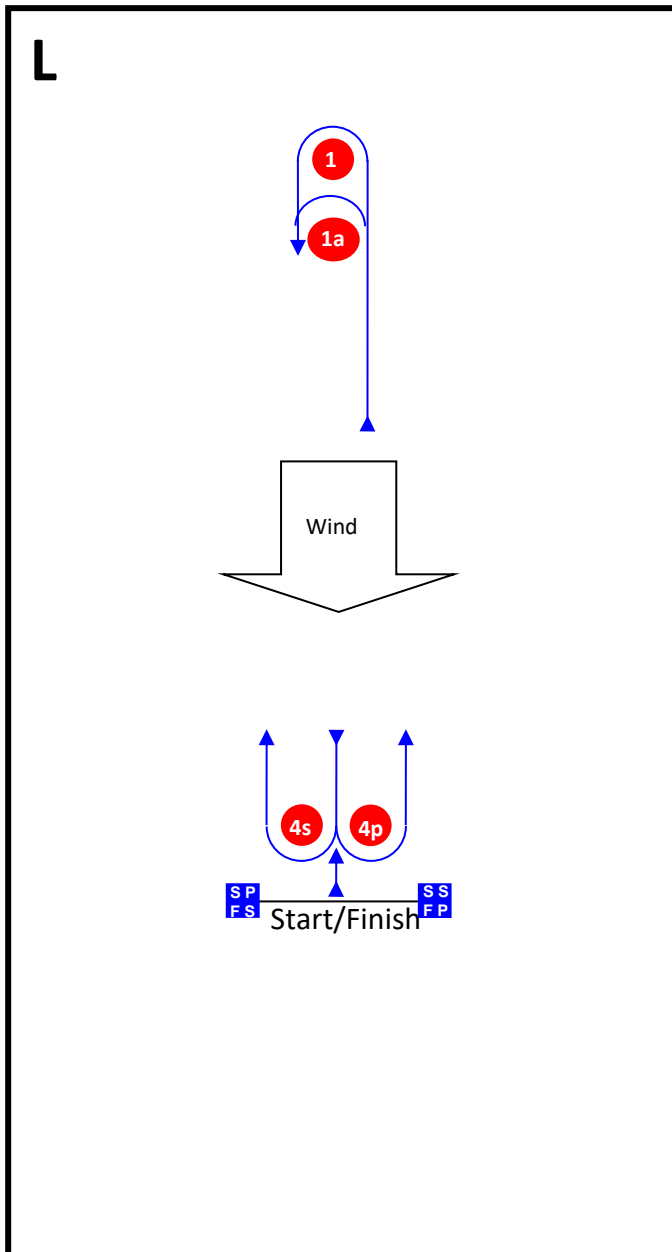
PENALTY SYSTEM

SSI 13 Rule 44.1 is changed so the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

SSI 14 Boats shall Sign Out and Sign In by signing the sheets located on the middle level of the Murrays Bay Sailing Club.
