SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSI)

This sheet and Attachment A are supplements to Appendix S of the Racing Rules of Sailing (page 136 RRS 2017-2020).

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS (SI 2)

SSI 1 The race office is located at Murrays Bay Sailing Club. Notices to competitors will be placed on the official notice board at Murrays Bay Sailing Club.

SIGNALS MADE ASHORE (SI 4)

SSI 2 Signals ashore will be displayed on the flagstaff located at Murrays Bay Sailing Club.

SSI 3 When a visual signal is displayed over a fleet(s) or course(s) flag, the signal applies only to that fleet(s) or course(s). This changes Race Signals preamble.

SSI 4 When flag AP is displayed ashore, "1 minute" is replaced by "not less than 30 minutes" in the race signal AP. This changes SI 4.2.

SSI 5 On each Race Day no warning signal will be made after 1700.

COURSES (SI 7)

SSI 6 The courses to be sailed, the order in which the marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left are shown in Attachment A. This may be amended by the Race Committee at the briefing.

MARKS (SI 8)

SSI 7 The description of the marks will be given at the briefing.

THE START (SI 9)

- SSI 8** To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.
- SSI 9** At the direction of the Race Committee at the briefing RRS 26, Starting Races, and SI 9.1 may be changed to the warning signal being displayed three (3) minutes before the starting signal and the preparatory signal being displayed two (2) minutes before the starting signal.
- SSI 10** When a starting sequence is in progress, boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area. The starting area is defined as the area 50 metres from the starting line and marks in all directions.

TIME LIMITS (SI 12)

Fleet/Class	Target time for first finisher	Finish Window	Race time limit
Optimist Green	20 minutes	15 minutes	45 minutes
All classes excluding Optimist Green	30 minutes	15 minutes	60 minutes

There is no prescribed time limit for the first boat to pass mark 1.

PENALTY SYSTEM

- SSI 11** For skiff and catamaran classes rule 44.1 is changed so the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.
- SSI 12** Appendix P is changed by SSI 11.

CHECK OUT AND CHECK IN

- SSI 13** Boats shall comply with the following check out and check in procedure: Sign on and off sheets are to be signed by all sailors each Race Day, prior to leaving the beach, and immediately after returning to the beach at the end of racing. A boat retiring from racing shall notify the Race Committee before leaving the racing area, or if that is not possible, shall notify the race office as soon as possible after returning ashore.
