SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSI)

This sheet and Attachment A are supplements to Appendix S of the Racing Rules of Sailing
(page 136 RRS 2017-2020).

RULES

- SSI 1** The series will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020.
- SS 2** The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part I shall apply.
- SS 3** The Tanner Cup Rules and Conditions shall apply.
- SS 4** Under RRS 86, Changes to the Racing Rules, racing rules will be changed as follows:
- i. RRS 35, A4 and A5 will be changed to state that boats failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish.
 - ii. RRS A4 and A5 will be changed to state that a boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start.
 - iii. Boats shall inform the committee boat at the finishing line of their intention to protest immediately after finishing. This changes RRS 61.3, Protest Time Limit.
 - iv. RRS 40 will be changed to require personal floatation devices to be worn at all times while afloat.
- SS 5** Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS (SI 2)

- SSI 6** The race office is located at Murrays Bay Sailing Club. Notices to competitors will be placed on the official notice board at Murrays Bay Sailing Club.

SIGNALS MADE ASHORE (SI 4)

- SSI 7** Signals ashore will be displayed on the flagstaff located at Murrays Bay Sailing Club.
- SSI 8** When flag AP is displayed ashore, “1 minute” is replaced by “not less than 30 minutes” in the race signal AP. This changes SI 4.2.

SCHEDULE OF RACES AND CLASS FLAGS (SI 5 & 6)

| Day/Date | Fleet/Class | Number of Races | Time of first warning signal | Class Flag |

| Sat 12 Dec | P Class | 3 | 1030 | P on a white flag |
| Sun 13 Dec | P Class | 3 | 1030 | P on a white flag |

SSI 9 One extra race per day may be sailed at the discretion of the Race Committee to ensure a series can be completed, provided that the regatta becomes no more than one race ahead of schedule.

SSI 10 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1500.

COURSES (SI 7)

SSI 11 The courses to be sailed, the order in which the marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left are shown in Attachment A.

MARKS (SI 8)

SSI 12 The description of the marks is in the table in Attachment A.

THE START (SI 9)

SSI 13 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.

TIME LIMITS (SI 12)

| Fleet/Class | Target time for first finisher | Finish Window | Race time limit |
|-------------|--------------------------------|---------------|-----------------|
| P Class | 40 | 15 | 70 |

There is no prescribed time limit for the first boat to pass mark 1.

PENALTY SYSTEM

SSI 14 Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, will apply.

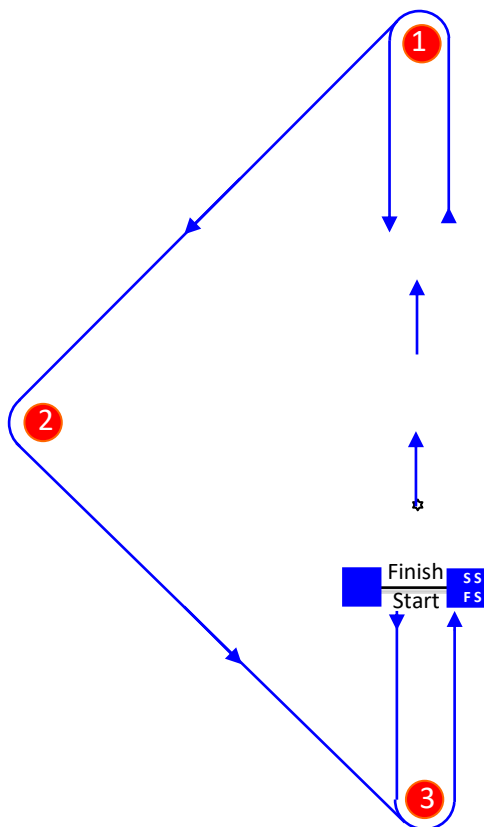
CHECK OUT AND CHECK IN

SSI 15 Boats shall comply with the following check out and check in procedure: Sign on and off sheets are to be signed by all sailors each Race Day, prior to leaving the beach and immediately after returning to the beach at the end of racing respectively. A boat retiring from racing shall notify the Race Committee before leaving the racing area, or if that is not possible, shall notify the race office as soon as possible after returning ashore.
